Although she has lived in the neighborhood for just over a year, through friends, collaborators, and neighbors, her ties to the community run deep and have allowed for commitment to preserve historically underserved neighborhoods.

Odell is a current student at Loyola University Maryland studying Communications and Media with a double concentration in Digital Media & Design, Advertising, and Public Relations. Before she officially established Barclay's in 2025, she started with a background in community organizing and food initiatives. Working alongside local groups to address this insecurity in access to food, and help promote a positive development. She has been vocal on her advocacy for anti-gentrification within the neighborhood, preserving space for those who are there.

Odell launched Barclay's with the idea that every community deserves access to fresh affordable food, and that the residents who reside should not be pushed out of neighborhoods they call home in the process. Her leadership centers in local ownership, community organization, and creating spaces where everyone feels seen and heard.

"Barclay's is more than just a corner store, it is a symbol that we belong. The people here who don't feel taken care of by their city, should have a space where they do. We built this for the people who actively choose to keep Harwood alive everyday."
